

How Can You Help

There are lots of ways you can help support your child through the PTA even if you only have a small amount of time available.

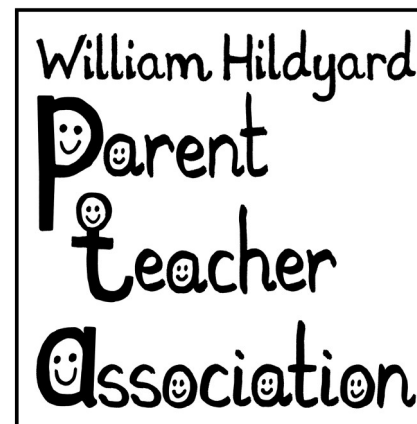

How We Raise Money

Like most PTAs, the majority of our funds are raised through the events that we run. Some of our most popular events are:

How We Spend the Money We Raise

We have funded or partly funded items such as:

- ◆ *Target boards on KS1 playground*
- ◆ *Science board on KS2 playground*
- ◆ *Outdoor play equipment*
- ◆ *Outdoor gym equipment*
- ◆ *Environmental area*
- ◆ *Forest Schools*
- ◆ *Resources for children with Additional Needs*
- ◆ *Christmas parties*
- ◆ *Theatre performances and workshops in school*
- ◆ *Microphones for performances*

The PTA also has ongoing commitments every year:

- We contribute to the children's Christmas parties and presents from a certain VIP when he visits the children just before Christmas
- Year 6 presents when they leave
- We partly fund replacement bark for play equipment and fund the ongoing maintenance
