These are your classrooms. You can arrive between 8:45 - 8:55 and say 'bye' to your grown-up on the playground. This is where we have our lessons. We use the interactive whiteboard every day.



Reception children put their book bags in a box by the main doors. They then put coats and P.E. bags on a named peg in the cloakroom. Nursery children also put their belongings on a named peg in the cloakroom. This is our snack area. You can choose a piece of fruit each day and help yourself when you feel hungry. You can also have free milk until you turn 5 years of age. It can then be paid for if you would still like to have a healthy drink. It is good to be healthy!

## We learn to read

We learn to read first by learning lots of different letter sounds. We use Jolly Phonics action songs and stories alongside Letters and Sounds. You will learn new letter sounds every week and be able to take home a sound book to help you remember them! Once you know some sounds you can begin to blend words to read.

You will get your own reading book to take home when you are ready for reading. Your grown-ups can write in your reading diary so we know you have read at home.

We also learn how to read tricky words. Tricky words are words that cannot be sounded out we just have to learn them by sight. When you are in Reception you will get a special tricky word book so you can practice these at home.

### We learn to write

In Nursery you will enjoy making marks and begin to form shapes that look like letters. In Reception you will learn to hold your pencil correctly. The pencil rests between the thumb and the first finger. The next finger prevents the pencil falling down and the last two fingers are tucked away. This is called a tripod grip.

When you learn new letter sounds you will also learn how to write them too. You will learn to write letters in a cursive style so that it is easier to join letters when you are a little bit bigger! First you will learn to write simple words for labels, then lists and then simple sentences.

You can practice writing in our lovely writing areas when you are choosing your own learning or working with an adult. There are lots of different reasons to write; you can write stories, cards, lists and invitations or even just a label to keep a model in the construction area!

What do you like writing about?






You will learn how to count objects very carefully. This will help you to add and subtract numbers using lots of different objects in our fun maths area!

You will learn to read, write and order numbers up to 10 and then 20. You may even learn some numbers up to 100! Which numbers do you already know? Can you write any numbers?







By the time you reach Reception, you will even learn how to solve simple problems by doubling and halving amounts.



## We learn about shapes and measuring




You will learn to measure using lots of different resources! You can explore time, length, height, weight, capacity and money in all sorts of fun ways.

You will learn all about shapes by making pictures, patterns and models using them! You will learn the names of 2D and 3D shapes and how to describe what the shapes are like.




# We learn how to use ICT
