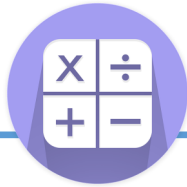

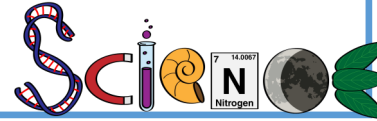

Maths - Place Value

We will continue our work on division, including long division methods and problems involving division. We will then move on to the topic of fractions, which includes adding and subtracting fractions, including equivalent fractions and mixed numbers.

Science - **Electricity** During this unit of work, children will construct simple series circuits and drawing them using scientific symbols. They will conduct investigations to determine how the voltage in a circuit affects the brightness of a bulb. They will use their 'working scientifically' skills to plan an experiment and use the results to write a clear conclusion.

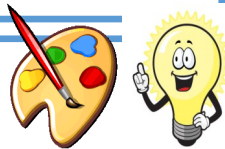


English - Non-Chronological Report

We will then be using the skills learnt in the Place Value of Punctuation and Grammar unit to write a non-chronological report about Famous Outlaws. We will then move on to writing letters.



Art - **Photo opportunity** Children will explore creative photographic techniques, creating new images through photomontage, understanding photorealistic self-portraits, and applying digital photography to art design.



Computing - Blogs

We will be reviewing and analysing the features of online blogs and what makes them successful before moving on to create our own.



History- **What can the census tell us about the local area?** This topic explores the history of the census and what information it collects. We will be looking at census's and using the information to make inferences about the past.



Spanish - At the shops

Children will explore key vocabulary such as names of shops, shopping items, clothes, adjectives and money.

RE - Do you have to believe in God to be good?

We will be looking at what it means to be 'good' and explore Buddhist and Humanist beliefs, including The Eightfold pass. Children will then look at how these beliefs impact on the way Buddhists and Humanists live their lives.



Music - **Film music** We will exploring different film music and how it conveys emotion and action . We will then create our own piece of music to convey an emotion.



PSHE - Celebrating Difference

We will explore differences and similarities and that for some people, being different is hard. The children will learn about bullying and how people can have power over others in a group.
