

# Year 4 Term 3 on a page



## Maths: Multiplication and Division and Length and perimeter.

We will be multiplying and dividing using all of our times tables. We will discuss what happens when we multiply and divide by 10 and 100 and work out strategies to help with division. We will be measuring length and finding the perimeter of different shapes including rectilinear shapes.

## Science: Sound

We will be learning about how sounds make vibrations and how our ears work to receive them. The children will investigate volume and pitch and evaluate their investigations.



## English: Charlie and the Chocolate factory by Roald Dahl, Egyptian Cinderella by Shirley Climo

We will be continuing our work looking at diary entry for a trip to Wonka's factory. We will also be thinking about a setting description of the factory and Wonka's world. We will be characterising speech whilst studying the Egyptian Cinderella.

## Art: Sculpture and 3D

We will design and carve sculptures using materials to create a 3D masterpiece. They will then explore different media and consider how their artwork can be displayed to different audiences.



## Computing: Animation

Children will learn about how to create animation using various skills and apps. They will be using apps and stop motion to create short sequences.



## PE: Basketball and Tag Rugby

We will be learning how to play basketball and Tag Rugby by developing the understanding of fair play and honesty while following rules of the games



## RE:

We will be learning about Islam this term. Children will investigate how Muslims express their beliefs collectively, How Muslim worship and celebration build a sense of community and the ways in which celebration and worship are related to what Muslims believe about the natural world and creation.




## History- What did the Ancient Egyptians believe?
