

Maths Fractions : unit and non-unit fractions. Compare and order fractions and order fractions on a number line and explore equivalent fractions.

Mass and capacity: measuring mass in kilograms and grams and capacity and volume in millilitres and litres. Add and subtract measurements.

Design Technology:

We will be designing, coding, making and promoting a Micro:bit electronic charm to use in low-light conditions. We will develop our understanding of programming to monitor and control our products.



Geography

We will be learning about lines of latitude and longitude and climate zones; developing an understanding of why seasons and climate zones occur; discussing the positions of the Arctic and Antarctic circles.



Music


 Theme: the Vikings

We will develop our singing technique. We will learn how to keep in time and work on musical notation and rhythm, and explore a group performance of a song with actions.



Science Forces and Magnets We will compare how things move on different surfaces and how some forces need contact between two objects. We will observe how magnets attract or repel each other and identify magnetic materials. We will describe magnets as having two poles and predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.



Computing Emailing : We will think about different methods of communication and learn how to open and respond to an email using an address book. We will learn how to use email safely and how to add an attachment to an email. We will then explore a simulated email scenario.




PE

Spanish This term we will be learning to greet people and introduce ourselves, classroom instructions and the Spanish alphabet.



English

We will start with reading the story Egyptian Cinderella and look at characterising speech. Then we will explore writing for a recount for a scientific experiment.
