

Fractions Understanding

This term's theme in music is rivers. The pupils will be learning about the pitch, tempo and dynamics of different styles of music.



Science

Electricity

Children will identify common appliances that run on electricity. We will learn to construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming the basic parts. Children will be able to recognise some basic conductors and the use of a switch.



Computing We will learn how to search for information effectively, locating information on the search results page and assessing whether an information source is true and reliable.



PE

Hockey

Children will focus on key skills such as dribbling, passing, receiving and intercepting the ball. This unit will also develop other important skills like collaboration, decision making and working safely with a team.

Children will recap naming the members of their family, name common family pets and begin to describe them.

Children will tell a story that entertains the reader, conveying character through dialogue.
