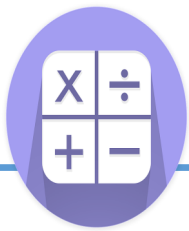




Let your light shine!

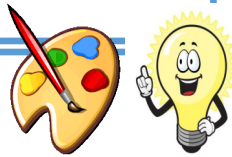


Maths

Music—Creating compositions

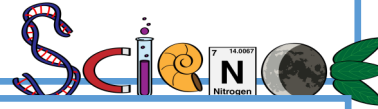
We look at story telling through music & discover how music can evoke strong thoughts and emotions.

In computing we will be learning how to use Google Slides to make presentations. We will add colour, text and media from the internet.

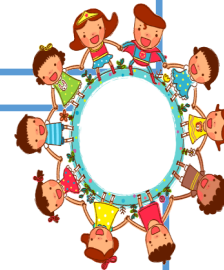


PE
