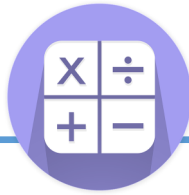




Let your light shine!



Maths: Place value and Addition and Subtraction.

We will be representing and partitioning numbers to 10,000. This will include ordering, comparing and rounding numbers. We will also be adding and subtracting four-digit numbers and learning strategies to check our work.

Art: Craft and design- Fabric of nature



Pupils will research and design mood boards and sketches themed on nature.

Geography: Why are rainforests important to us?



We will be focusing on rainforests as a biome including which animals live there and how it is changing.

Music-Body and tuned percussion (Rainforest)

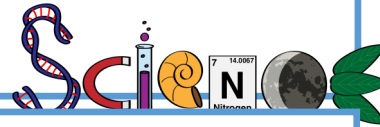
Children will learn to use their bodies and tuned instruments for percussion rhythms to create a rainforest theme.

Science: Living things and their habitats

We will be learning about how we can group animals and plants. This will include vertebrates and invertebrates and the habitats animals live in to help them achieve the seven processes of living.



Computing: Unpacking hardware and software

Children will explore 2code to understand technology and how it impacts our daily lives and how we use software to complete jobs.



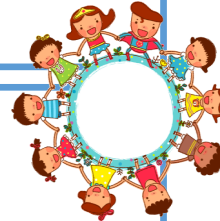
PE: Swimming and Gymnastics



We will be swimming and develop balancing, rolling, jumping and inverted movements in gymnastics.

PSHE: Being me in my world.

We will be learning about the rights and responsibilities of being a citizen in our community, class, school and world. We think about how our actions affect others.



Spanish- My town

We will be learning to describe places in a town and give our address in Spanish. We will be learning to count to 100 in Spanish and finding out about cultural differences in Spain.



English: Greta and the Giants by Zoe Tucker and Last by Nicola Davies

We will be reading Greta and the Giants and writing fact files about Greta Thunberg.

We will be writing non-chronological reports about extinct animals using headings, subheadings and technical vocabulary. We will be focusing on ensuring we understand lots of the grammar for Year 4 too!

RE: Why do we celebrate.

We will be learning about celebrations from different religions and the reasons for these including remembrance Sunday, Christian confirmation, celebration of a new baby in different faiths and Jewish Shabbat. We will learn to compare and contrast different celebrations and explore the importance for those that celebrate.
