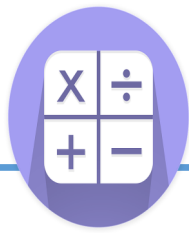


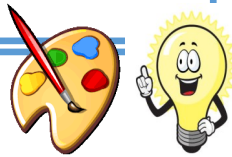


Let your light shine!

## Music

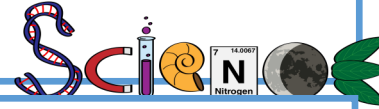
Contrasting dynamics—we will be exploring how to use pitch and soundscapes to create music.

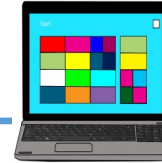
## Science

In Science we will focus on plants, investigating what they need and where they grow, along with exploring seasonal changes that we see in our environment.



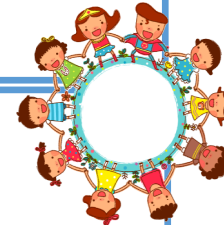
## Computing

In dance we will listen to music and use our bodies to respond to it, before putting a sequences of movements together. In outdoor PE we will be learning techniques in sending and receiving objects.

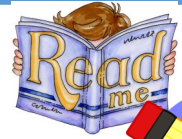


## PSHE— Dreams and goals
