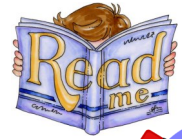

Maths: Multiplication and Division and Length and perimeter.

We will be finishing multiplying and dividing using all of our times tables. We will discuss what happens when we multiply and divide by 10 and 100 and work out strategies to help with division. We will be measuring length and finding the perimeter of different shapes including rectilinear shapes.

Science: Sound

We will be learning about how sounds make vibrations and how our ears work to receive them. The children will investigate volume and pitch and evaluate their investigations.

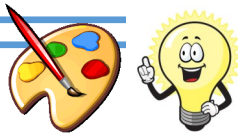


English: How to raid a settlement Beowulf by Rob Lloyd Jones, Water cycle explanation

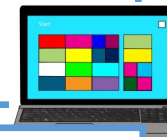
Art: Sculpture and 3D

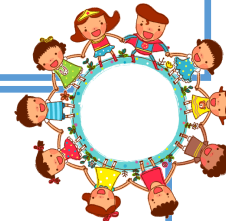
History- What changed in Britain after the Anglo Saxon invader.
