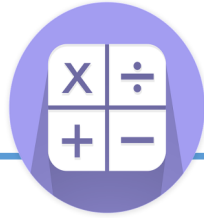
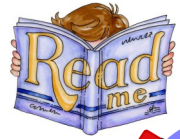

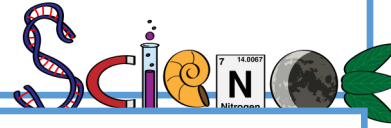
Maths:

Measurement and Multiplication and Division

We will also be investigating and calculating area. We will then move onto multiplying and dividing using all of our times tables.

Science: States of matter

We will be learning about solids, liquids and gases and how we can classify these. We will learn about how some liquids behave like a solid and some solids behave like a liquid. Children will learn how we can change a state of matter and how some of these may be reversible.

We will be looking at diary entry for a trip to Wonka's factory. We will also be thinking about a setting description of the factory and Wonka's world and a setting in nature. Moving onto a discussion text about whether the factory should or shouldn't be shut down.



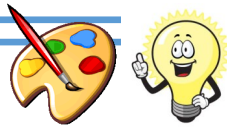
Computing: Animation

Children will learn about different kinds of animations and techniques such as onion skinning to create their own animations and narratives.

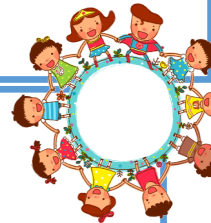
History- How did the achievements of the Maya civilisation influence their society and beyond.
