Maths - Fractions

This term the children will become fraction experts! They'll learn how to work with fractions, decimals, and percentages, and see how they connect. They will know how to simplify and compare fractions as well as using the four operations. Including mixed numbers and improper fractions.



DT - Waistcoats In this project, children will become fashion designers and tailors! They'll design, make, and evaluate their very own waistcoat. They will plan, measure, sew and assemble their creations ready for evaluation.



Geography- Why does population change?

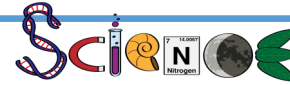
In this unit, children will be learning all about people- how many there are, where they live, and why those numbers change over time. We will explore births, deaths, migration and how population differs around the world.

Music - Dynamics, pitch and texture.

We explore how music brings movies to life. We will discover how composers use sound to make us feel emotions, build tension, and tell stories — even without words.



Science - Electricity



Children will understand what electricity is through building and exploring simple circuits. They will also learn about circuit components and explore conductors and insulators, making predictions and using their investigative skills.

Computing - Blogging

Children will explore blogs and their features, including how they can be used to engage an audience effectively.



Spanish - At the shops

Children will practise new words, phrases, and conversations to help you ask for things, talk about prices, and buy items in different types of shops.

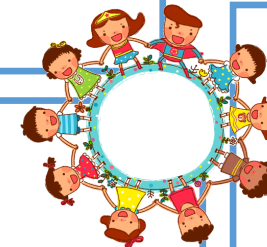
PE- Netball and Yoga

Netball- In Year 6 Netball, pupils develop passing, footwork, teamwork and tactical skills while learning game rules and positions. They apply these in small games and matches to build confidence and cooperation.

Yoga- In Year 6 Yoga, pupils explore balance, flexibility, and mindfulness through a range of poses and sequences. They learn to control their breathing, improve focus, and relax their bodies and minds.

PSHE - Being me in my world

Children learn about diversity, respect and what makes everyone unique, exploring how to challenge bullying and discrimination while celebrating what makes us all special.



English - Horror Genre



Year 6 will be reading short extracts from a range of stories from the horror genre such as Clockwork by Phillip Pullman and Dracula by Bram Stoker working on key reading skills. The children will also write their own setting descriptions and narrative based on the themes inspired by a stimulus.

RE - Good/evil and the things which influence moral and ethical viewpoints



We will look at beliefs about God, and continue to explore the existence of God. Children will also explore concepts of good and evil, right and wrong and how we care for the world around us.
