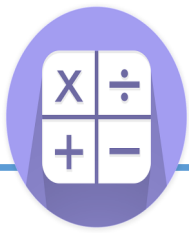

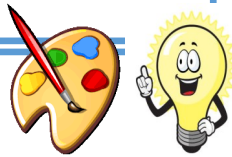


### Maths

### Music— Traditional instruments & improvisation.

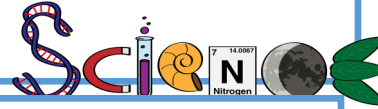
We will learn to verbalise feelings about music & sing and play in time with others .



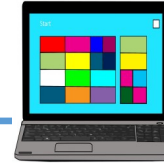

#### Athletics

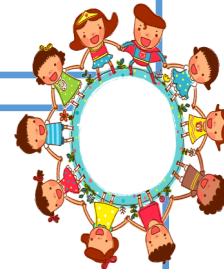
**& Golf.** We will develop basic running, throwing & jumping techniques.
