Maths This term in Maths, Year 1 children will develop their understanding of number and measurement through the topics Position and Direction, Place Value, Money and Time. They will build fluency in recognising, comparing and applying mathematical concepts in practical and problem-solving contexts.



DT/ Art Children will explore painting and mixed media through the Colour Splash unit. They will develop their skills in colour mixing, brush techniques and composition, while experimenting creatively with different materials.

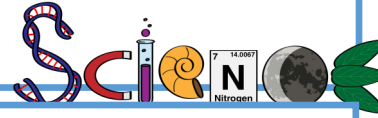


Geography Children will explore what it is like to live in Shanghai and comparing it to what it is like to live in Lincolnshire. We will look at the difference between physical and human features.

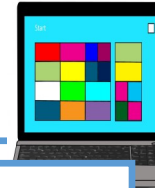
Music Children will combine the musical concepts they have learned throughout the year to prepare an underwater-themed performance. They will use instrumental, vocal and body sounds to create and perform music.



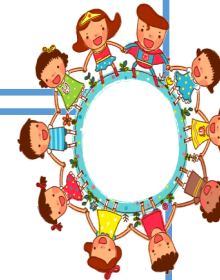
Science This term, children will learn about how plants grow and where food comes from. They will explore farming, healthy eating and plant growth through practical activities such as planting and preparing simple



Computing In Computing, children will be introduced to programming through animation using Scratch Jr. They will learn how to use, modify and create simple programs using coding blocks, developing their understanding of sequencing and logical thinking.



PE In PE, children will develop their skills in athletics and striking and fielding. They will practise running, jumping and coordination skills, as well as learning to make simple tactical decisions such as moving into space and working as part of a



PSHE . Children will focus on the theme Changing Me. They will explore how people change over time and learn strategies for coping positively with change, supporting their emotional understanding and resilience.



English In English, we will look more in depth and the story Jack and the beanstalk and the features of traditional tales.

In phonics, the children will continue to learn Set 2 and Set 3 sounds. They will also practice reading real and pseudo 'alien' words in preparation for the Phonics Screening Check.

RE In RE, the children will learn about different festivals from Christianity, Islam and Judaism. We will be exploring why Easter, Passover and Ramadan are celebrated, how they are celebrated and what believers learn from these.
